Dear UHS Parents/Guardians and Students:

On Wednesday, October 13, 2021, all sophomores and juniors will be taking the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT). The PSAT is a practice form of the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) which provides feedback on a student's strengths and weaknesses on skills necessary for college study. This feedback will prove beneficial in focusing on the areas that could most benefit from additional study or practice.

Another benefit to taking the PSAT is eligibility for the National Merit Scholarship Program. The National Merit Scholarship Program is a United States academic scholarship competition for recognition and university scholarships administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.

On October 13th, all sophomores and juniors are to report to their assigned testing homerooms no later than 7:35 AM. All freshmen and seniors are to report to school at 10:35 AM. Freshman should enter the school through the main entrance, and seniors should enter by the big gym (rock) entrance.

The time schedule for October 13th will be altered. Lunch will be served during regular lunch periods, and dismissal will be at 2:35 PM.

Transportation will pick up all sophomore and junior bus students who will be taking the PSAT at their normal stop and time. All freshmen and senior bus students should be at their normal bus stop by 10:00 AM. Students that take a contracted bus (not Union Twp transportation) will be picked up at the regular time every day.
