Any other students who are interested are to sign up in the Athletic Department to retake this test. These students will report 1st period to the Cafeteria.

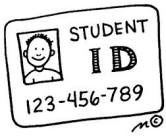

If dues and/or fines are not paid you will not be able to purchase a prom ticket, participate in end of year senior activities, also your cap/gown and diploma will be withheld until the dues and fines are paid. NOTE: Students can accumulate more fines at the end of the year (after 3/29) if books/items are not returned. Please be mindful of return procedures.
