2018-2019 WINTER SPORTS

All paperwork must be submitted to the Nurse's Office by Monday, October 15th.

You need a physical exam if:

- Your physical on file will expire **before 11/19/18** (physicals are good for one year)
- You do not have a physical on file

You need a 90 day update if:

- You have a current physical on file

You CANNOT try-out, practice or participate in your sport until your 90-day update has been processed or your athletic physical has been cleared by the school doctor. Please ask now if you have any questions.

Please do not wait until the last minute!!! We do not want you to be disappointed.
