On Wednesday, October 11, all sophomores and juniors will be taking the PSAT. The PSAT is a practice form of the SAT. The SAT is a test determined to measure a student's academic potential in college. By taking the PSAT, your child has a better chance of scoring well on the SAT.

On this date, sophomores and juniors are to report to their assigned testing homerooms no later than 7:30 a.m.

All other students (freshmen and seniors) are to report to school at 10:35 a.m. Freshmen should enter the building at the main entrance. Seniors should enter by the main gym (rock entrance).

The time schedule for October 11th will be altered; lunch will be served during regular lunch periods; dismissal will be at 2:35 p.m.

Transportation will pick up all 10th and 11th graders who will be taking the PSAT and are eligible for bussing at their normal stop and time. All other bus students (9th and 12th graders NOT taking the test) should be at their normal bus stop by 9:30 a.m.
