

## Union High School's Title 1 Program Plan

2016-2017

Union High School has created a "Title 1 Tutoring/Enrichment Program for all eligible students. Students who participate in the program will receive special instruction emphasizing problem solving and critical thinking skills in Mathematics, Writing, Social Studies, and Science. The purpose of the program is to provide supplemental learning experiences in one or more of these academic areas. Students receive group and or individual instruction based on academic needs.

Students are eligible for the program based on the following criteria:

- Progress Report of 70% and below
- P.A.R.C.C Test Scores
- Teacher Recommendation

Students are eligible to exit the program based on the following criteria:

- Second semester progress report 77% and higher
- End of marking period benchmark of 77% and higher
- Teacher Recommendations
