



Union High School Title 1 Transition Summer Program 2018

Union High School has created a “Title 1 Transition Program for 8th grade students who will be entering the high school as a freshman for the 2018-2019 school year. Our mission is to provide your child with the academic knowledge and skills which will assist them in reaching their educational goals. Students who participate in our intensive program will receive special instruction emphasizing problem solving and critical thinking skills in Math, Science, and English.

The program will begin Thursday, July 5, 2018 through Tuesday, July 31, 2018. Days and times are as follows: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:00A.M.- 12:00P.M. All students are expected to arrive on time for school. Any student arriving tardy 3 times during the program will be removed permanently. Breakfast and lunch will also be served to participating students.

Students are eligible for the program based on the following criteria:

- Progress Report of 70% and below
- PARRC Test Scores
- Teacher Recommendation

It is very important that students who participate in this program are committed and consistently attend everyday (Monday-Thursday) to fully benefit from the instruction. Students are expected to follow rules and regulations implemented by Union High School.
