Title I, Part A: Purpose

- “...is to provide all children significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps.”
- Title I is a federally funded K-12 program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities for students.
- Title I will provide additional resources so that all students meet state academic standards.
- TUPS has all Schoolwide Title I Programs.



Scope of Title I

Over 26 million students served	Over 530,000 students served
Federal allocation of over \$14 billion	Allocation of over \$350 million
Over 66,000 schools serving more than 26 million students	Instructional Services: English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science

Use of Title I Funds

Title I funds are to be used to directly impact student achievement by:

- *Providing additional services that increase the amount and quality of instructional time.
- *Providing students with an enriched and accelerated academic program.
- *Significantly elevating the quality of instruction.
- *Affording parents substantial and meaningful opportunities to participate in the education of their children.



We are a “Schoolwide” Title I School

- ALL students, staff and parents/families eligible for Title I funded services.
- ALL students become “Title I students”.
- ALL teachers become “Title I teachers”.
- ALL parents become “Title I parents”.
- “The purpose of a schoolwide program is to improve academic achievement throughout a school so that all students, particularly the lowest-achieving students, demonstrate proficiency related to the challenging State academic standards...”



Plan for Student Achievement

- Each school develops an Annual School Plan using data analysis. The school develops the yearlong plan that is organized into SMART goals, activity steps and budget needs.
